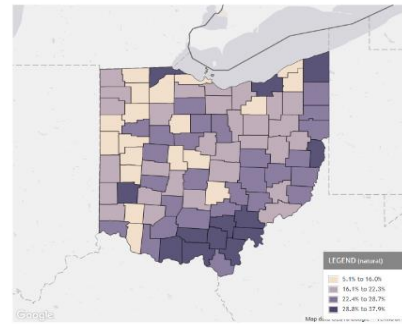


State of Ohio

Percent of Children in Poverty, 2014



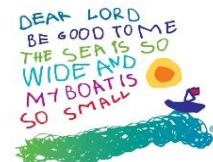
